In the comfort of a luxury motor coach, we will travel to the historical crash site of Flight 93 in Shanksville where a program will be provided by a U.S. Park Service Ranger. Next, we will travel to the Shanksville School Gardens dedicated to Flight 93. It features the bronze sculpture of hands representing all of the fallen heroes. The donated gardens convey the gratitude of people from all over the United States. A boxed lunch will be enjoyed at the Stoneycreek Park Pavilion. We will then visit the Flight 93 Memorial Chapel and Gardens where Father Mascherino will present a program in the Chapel. Transportation Will Be Provided

Come join us in a tour led by Monsignor Balta of the only Byzantine Catholic Church in the United States to showcase a ceramic baldacchino. It is a gazebo-like structure that inspired the colors, designs, and patterns utilized throughout the church. The baldacchino took craftsmen 6 years to build. The interior consists of marble from throughout the world, German stained glass windows, and brilliant colored murals depicting Biblical stories. St. Mary's is also home to a structural beam from the Twin Towers. The steel piece serves as a memorial to the heroes and victims of 9-11. Enjoy a behind the scenes tour of the high-tech kitchen utilized to prepare thousands of stuffed cabbage, dumplings, and pierogies.

Johnstown Flood Museum & Inclined Plane Self-Guided Tour

Johnstown Flood Museum—Cost: Adults \$6.00 & Seniors \$5.00— The Flood of 1889 occurred whenever a neglected dam burst flooding the valley below and killing 2,209 people. View exhibits, artifacts and the Academy Award Winning Film The Johnstown Flood. See the example of the first prefab home, a restored Oklahoma house. These were used to shelter flood survivors. Located 4 blocks from Holiday Inn Downtown Johnstown at 304 Washington Street, Downtown Johnstown. (See map in your registration packet for directions to the museum.) **Use Museum Tour Guides.**

Inclined Plane— Cost: Adults Roundtrip \$4.00 & Seniors with proper ID (driver's license) are free— It runs every 15 minutes and opens on Friday at 7:15 a.m. & Saturday and Sunday at 8:15 a.m. The world's steepest vehicular plane with a 71.9% grade was built in the aftermath of the 1889 Flood so people could live in safety off of the flood plain. Located 2 blocks from the Conference Center at 711 Edgehill Drive, Downtown Johnstown. (See map in your registration packet.)
